Revere, Chelsea and Lawrence receive first donations Tues., Nov. 24

Woburn, Massachusetts (November 24, 2020) – [Mascon Medical](#), a subsidiary of [Mascon, Inc.](#), a leading minority-owned manufacturing and supply chain company with more than 40 years of industry experience in Woburn, Massachusetts, is donating more than **\$1 million in personal protective equipment (PPE) and infection control products** to Massachusetts communities hit hardest by Covid-19. This includes masks, gowns, face shields, goggles, hand sanitizing wipes, and electrostatic sprayers.

“From the onset of this pandemic, our team has been committed to helping address the issues surrounding Covid-19 PPE supplies,” said **John R. Chen, Global President & CEO of Mascon, Inc.** “As we approach the holiday season, we hope this donation will provide critical support to those hit hardest, especially hospitals, schools and area non-profits including shelters and food pantries.”

Among the first to receive this precious supply are Revere, Chelsea and Lawrence, which are considered at the highest risk for transmitting the new coronavirus in Massachusetts, according to the latest weekly community-level data on the pandemic by the Commonwealth’s Department of Public Health.

“We will be getting these supplies directly into the hands of Revere residents, as well as our community partners who have joined us in working tirelessly to distribute PPE to those who need it most,” said **Revere Mayor Brian Arrigo**. “As we head into the season of giving during these unprecedented times, we’re grateful to partners like Mascon that have stepped up to support our residents and to show that we will get through these challenges by working together.”

As worldwide cases of COVID-19 approached 1 million, the team at Mascon Medical proactively led the charge on the development of safe, easily accessible, and affordable PPE for infection control purposes. The PPE developed by Mascon Medical includes UV-C lighting for clean air, Electrostatic Disinfecting sprayers and formulas for surfaces, sanitizing wipes and hand sanitizers that have all been through extensive third-party testing for safety.

“From the beginning, our team had been working tirelessly to bring the best infection control products to the market and using our extensive supply chain network,” said Chen. “We have been able to support critical efforts on the testing side by supplying medical consumables to Covid-19 testing labs around the country.”

Following a [September 2020 CDC report](#) that shed light on the 277,285 confirmed COVID-19 cases for U.S. children, Mascon Medical raced to collaborate with [Safer Teachers, Safer Students: Back-to-School Testing Collaborative](#) to provide the time and information needed to help underprivileged metropolitan Boston cities get teachers and students safely back to school. To supplement this movement, Mascon Medical promised to donate at least 10% of the revenue it receives from its infection control sales back to the communities most in need.
